INTRATEST'S PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

At Intratest we take our responsibilities seriously when it comes to processing and storing personal data even though we operate within the Business-to-Business environment.

To us personal data connected to our stakeholder's businesses (i.e. customers, employees, sub-contractors and suppliers), and occasionally prospects businesses, such as full name, postal address, telephone number(s), and email address(s) will only be collected and managed in connection with us offering and delivering our services.

Information Security

All business based personal data is stored electronically, either on email systems or specific customer contract (or job) related folders with a proportion being paper related, and Intratest is committed to develop and enhance processes connected to Information Security presently operating to the guidelines published in the governments Cyber Essentials Scheme.

Marketing and Consent

Occasionally we may source data for marketing purposes from industry specific websites and publications such as The Institute of Lighting Professional (ILP)'s magazine, The Highway Electrical Association (HEA)'s website, or the Highway Electrical Yearbook, taking the initial approach to consent being one of legitimate interest to build mutually beneficial business relationships.

However, as part of the ongoing marketing activities, we will discuss and where relevant obtain a more formal consent to ongoing communication to ensure compliance to The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that comes into force on 25th May 2018.

On no account will personal data be shared with a third party unless deemed critical to Intratest's ongoing success (e.g. personal data for reference purposes connected to approved supplier status, prequalification questionnaires – PQQs, Request for Quotes – RFQs, or Tender Responses), and only then to contracted suppliers and potential customer organisations, once permission has been granted by those involved.

To restrict processing

If you wish to opt-out or unsubscribe from mailing lists, then either follow the unsubscribe facility at the end of specific communications (e.g. marketing emails) or submit a request to Intratest.

To data portability

Intratest does not provide data to third parties unless prior permission has been granted. (see above)

To object
